Please click at each information on the webpages above and read the instructions how to apply and what are the documents to be downloaded during your online application, available study programs, host institutions and coordinators, rights and obligations, etc. . Be aware that the first technical check it is an online application and your documents . The applications successfully submitted in Tempus Public Foundation's online application surface are first checked. This is called a technical check and it is done by Tempus Public Foundation. Further selection process, please read at the guide. The final professional decision will be by Hungarian side.

Important : As you see except that you have to apply online and you fulfill all the criteria that are necessary for stipendium Hungaricum application, you might be contacted by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Kosova , if you have a successful online application to provide a list of documents to the Ministry . Please save a copy of each documents that you will download during your online application , in order to have all copies if we will require from you. The documents has to be translated in English from an official legal person.

You can bring only copies of them in the Ministry of Education , because the originals you will use for your personal reason , if you may be awarded for the scholarship and you might need to send to the Host Partner..

Scholarship framework for students :

1. Full degree bachelor studies: Any, with priority given to: Agriculture, Arts, Arts and Humanities, Social Sciences and Economic Science

2. Full degree master studies: Any, with priority given to: Agriculture, Arts, Arts and Humanities, Social Sciences and Economic Science

3. Full degree doctoral studies: In any academic field.

Application “Dos and Don'ts”

Please make sure that :

-you read and understand all parts of the Call for Application, especially the eligibility criteria (e.g. age and citizenship requirements)

-you read the guide (available on www.stipendiumhungaricum.hu website) for the online application system,

- you visit the website of Tempus Public Foundation (<http://studyinhungary.hu/study-inhungary/menu/find-a-study-programme/study-finder.html>)

and your chosen Host Institutions for details about the entrance requirements of study programmes, curriculum and so on,

-if you are a doctoral applicant, visit <http://www.doktori.hu> and contact your chosen host institution before submitting your institution in order to discuss the available research topics and possible supervisors (you will have priority if you already have an assigned future supervisor),

- you provide precise contact details and make sure your e-mail address (and any other information)

- is not mistyped on your application form because all information – including the selection results will be sent there,

- you do not accidentally apply for the wrong study levels (e.g. doctoral studies while you are a bachelor student or master studies while you already have a master degree) and do not apply to

different study levels in one application,

- you do not mix up the application to full degree and partial (exchange) study programme (and the length of exchange studies) as it cannot be altered after the application is submitted,
- the documents with the correct file formats are uploaded, one file is not larger than 4 MB and all your files can be opened,
- you submit your application until the deadline both to Tempus Public Foundation and the responsible authorities of the Sending Partner,
- you did submit your application because the saving your application will only save the content but the application will not actually be submitted,
- you write down and remember your login information, password and your e-mail address used when you submitted your application because you will need these information later (e.g. for accepting the scholarship), and
- you write down and remember your application registration number because this is how we will be able to identify your application later and this is the number that Scholarship Holders will need to use during their scholarship studies too.

We highly suggest you to

- increase your chances of getting admitted by applying for three different study programmes (in order of preference) instead of only one or two,
- carefully decide on the order of application as it cannot be changed later and it is very much considered during the allocation process (read important details above)
- not to apply through any agencies unknown by the Host Institutions (see our website for the list of agencies known by the universities) and pay for their services regarding the application because the programme is implemented by direct cooperation with the responsible authorities of the Sending Partners, not agencies.

Non-eligibility

Applications will not be considered in the following cases:

- Hungarian citizens (including those with dual citizenships).

- Applicants with a citizenship different from the sending country/territory. For example, only Brazilian citizens can apply through the Brazilian Sending Partner.
- Applicants born after 31 August 2000 (= applicants under 18 years old as of 31 August 2018) **except** applicants applying for Dance study programmes,
- Applicants who will not hold a secondary school graduation certificate until 1 August 2018,
- Those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who were **awarded for full degree studies** and who
 - are now re-applying for full degree or partial (exchange) studies **in the same cycle of education** (non-degree studies, bachelor, master, one-tire master, doctoral level) – **therefore, those Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders can apply for the programme who apply to continue their studies at a different cycle of education, e.g. bachelor scholarship holders can apply for master studies!**
 - or who are now re-applying for the programme for any cycles of education while they still have a scholarship status at the time of application (unless they withdraw their former scholarship before the application deadline) and will not receive their degree until 31 August 2018,
 - or who have postponed the start date of their scholarship studies and did not withdraw their scholarship before the current application deadline.
- Those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who were **awarded for partial (exchange) studies** and who
 - are now re-applying for partial (exchange) studies in the same cycle of education (non-degree studies, bachelor, master, one-tire master, doctoral level) – therefore, those Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders can apply for a different cycle of education, e.g. former bachelor scholarship holders can apply for master partial (exchange) studies if they are now master students in their home countries!

Therefore, please note that it is only possible to re-apply for full degree scholarship studies in the same cycle of education if the former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holder was previously awarded for partial (exchange) studies! Even in this case, the lengths of the full degree scholarship shall be reduced by the lengths of the previous partial (exchange) studies.
