

## NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

### APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

For submitting your application, please do read carefully paragraph 9. Application Procedure of the Application Guidelines Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho:MEXT) Scholarship for 2017 (Undergraduate Students). You will have to submit all documents required there, **except numbers ② Placement Preference Form (a prescribed form) and ⑥ Medical certificate (a prescribed form)**. These documents are not necessary for the first application round.

### TIMETABLE

1. Initial applications to be submitted to the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology by **May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016** at the latest. Applications arriving after this date will not be considered.
2. **Mid of June:** Selected candidates will receive a letter of invitation to an academic examination (applicants for a major in Social Sciences and Humanities must sit for mathematics, English and Japanese; applicants for a major in Natural Sciences must sit for mathematics, English, physics, chemistry, biology and Japanese) and an interview (**Mid/End of June 2016**) by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology and the Japanese Embassy. On this occasion candidates will be selected for recommendation to the Monbukagakusho.
3. **December 2016:** Successful applicants will be notified of their acceptance by Monbukagakusho.
4. **February 2017:** Candidates will be given notification of their final acceptance and placement by Monbukagakusho.
