You will have to submit all documents required there, **except numbers Placement Preference Form (a prescribed form) and (6) Medical certificate (a prescribed form)**. These documents are not necessary for the first application round.

TIMETABLE

- 1. Initial applications to be submitted to the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology by **May 15, 2015** at the latest. Applications arriving after this date will not be considered.
- 2. Beginning of June: Selected candidates will receive a letter of invitation to an academic examination (applicants for a major in Social Sciences and Humanities must sit for mathematics, English and Japanese; applicants for a major in Natural Sciences must sit for mathematics, English, physics, chemistry, biology and Japanese) and an interview (Beginning of July 2015) by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology and the Japanese Embassy. On this occasion candidates will be selected for recommendation to the Monbukagakusho.
- 3. **December 2015:** Successful applicants will be notified of their acceptance by Monbukagakusho.
- 4. **February 2016:** Candidates will be given notification of their final acceptance and placement by Monbukagakusho.
