This publication presents statistical data for: preschool / pre-primary education, primary education, lower secondary education, upper secondary education, education of children/students with special needs and higher education (university). The source of data for pre-university education is the Education Information Management System (EIMS). While data for public and private Higher Education are collected by KAS through the CAWI web application.

MESTI and KAS are grateful to all those who contributed to the preparation of this publication.

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1. Introduction

The publication: "Education Statistics in Kosovo 2024-2025" is the result of cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Innovation (MESTI) and the Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS). The source of data for pre-university education is the Education Information Management System (EMIS). This publication does not include statistical data from the Serbianian community, with the exception of data for the municipality of Kamenica, which reports to EMIS. Data on public and private university education was provided by KAS.

1. 1. Description

The publication: "Education Statistics in Kosovo 2024-2025" contains data on:

- the number of children in preschool and pre-primary education by gender, nationality,
- age groups and educational personnel for this level;
- the number of students in primary education and lower secondary education by gender, nationality, grades and educational staff for this level;
- the number of students in upper secondary education by gender, nationality, professional schools/gymnasiums and educational staff for this level;
- the number of children/students with special needs by gender, grade and type of impairment/difficulty;
- the number of students in university education by gender, nationality, faculties/study programs, level of study (bachelor and master), the number of graduates at bachelor and master levels, academic staff, etc.

1. 2. Definitions

Preschool education

The level of preschool/pre-primary education represents level zero. according to IASB (International Standard Classification of Education) or ISCED 2011 and is divided into two categories: category 01 which includes ages 0-2 and is called Early Childhood Development and category 02 which includes ages 3-5 (ages 3-4 is called preschool education, while age 5 is called pre-primary education).

Compulsory education

Compulsory education represents levels one and two according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education) or ISCED 2011. Primary education is classified as level 1 (grades 1-5) and lower secondary education as level 2 (grades 6-9).

Compulsory education at the national level is organized in public and non-public educational institutions (licensed by MESTI).

Primary education level

The primary education level lasts 5 years, starting from first grade to fifth grade (grades 1-5).

Children who reach the age of 6 are enrolled at this level, while the age group of students at this level is from 6 to 10 years old.

Lower secondary education level

The lower secondary education level starts from the sixth to the ninth grade (grades 6-9) and includes students in the age group from 11 to 14. The learning process for this level is organized in public and non-public educational institutions (licensed by MESTI).

Upper secondary education level

The level of upper secondary education represents level three (3) according to the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) or ISCED 2011 and the learning process is organized in public and non-public educational institutions (licensed by MESTI).

Based on their goals and program content, these schools are organized into gymnasiums and professional schools.

Upper secondary schools (gymnasiums and professional schools) are specialized schools.

Gymnasiums are divided according to the following majors: social sciences, general sciences, natural sciences, mathematics-informatics, and languages.

Meanwhile, professional schools are divided according to the following fields: technical, agricultural, economic, medical, music, trade, theological, art, and centers of competence.

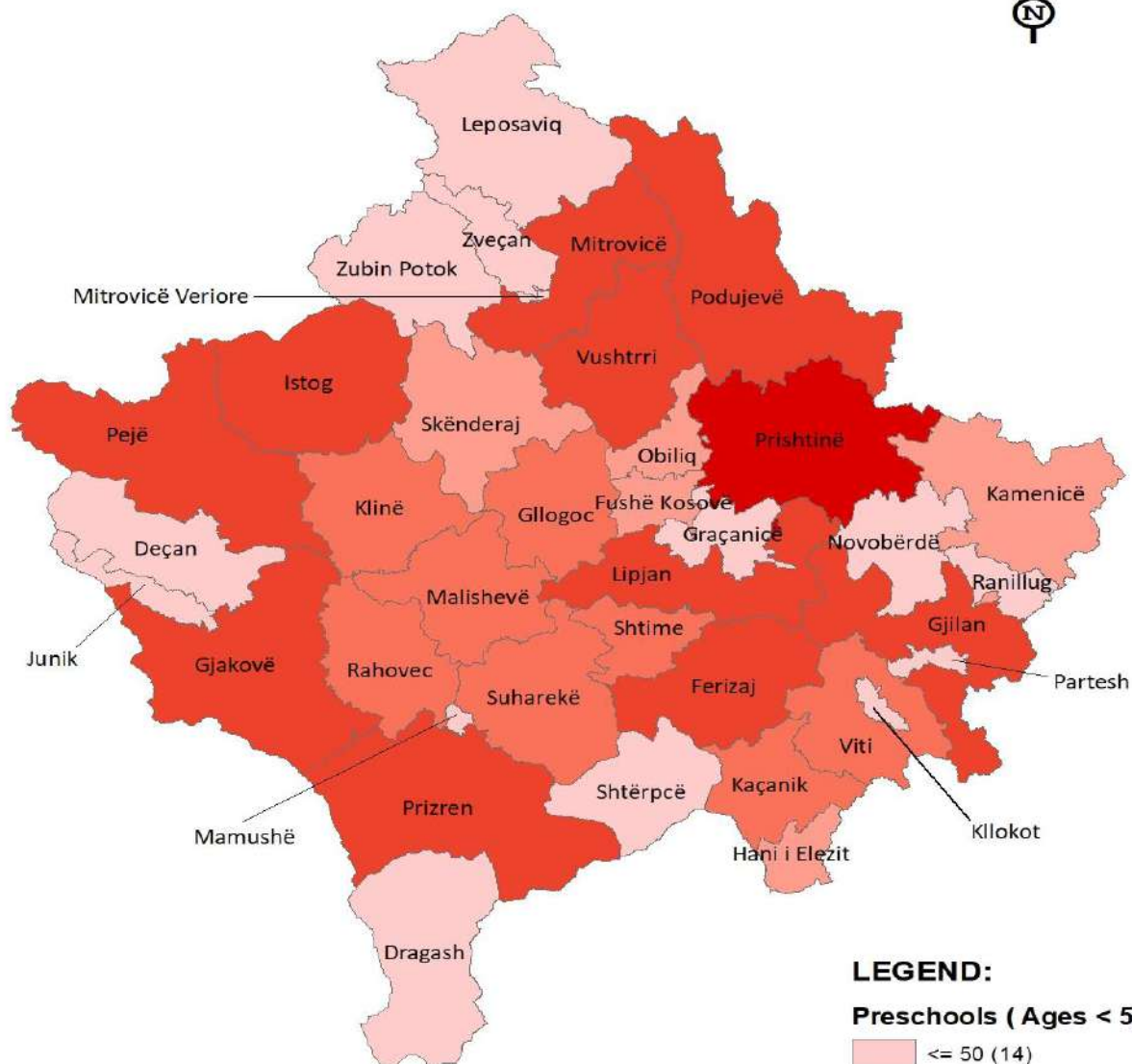

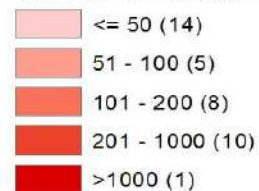
NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN PRESCHOOL EDUCATION ACCORDING TO MUNICIPALITY, 2024/2025

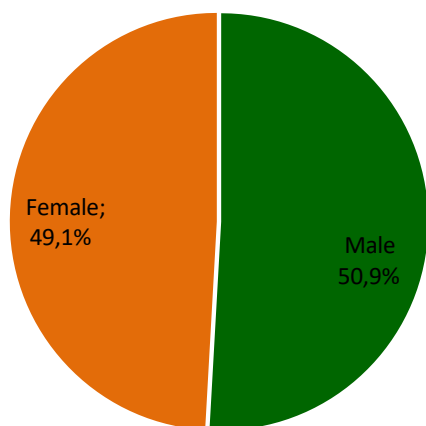

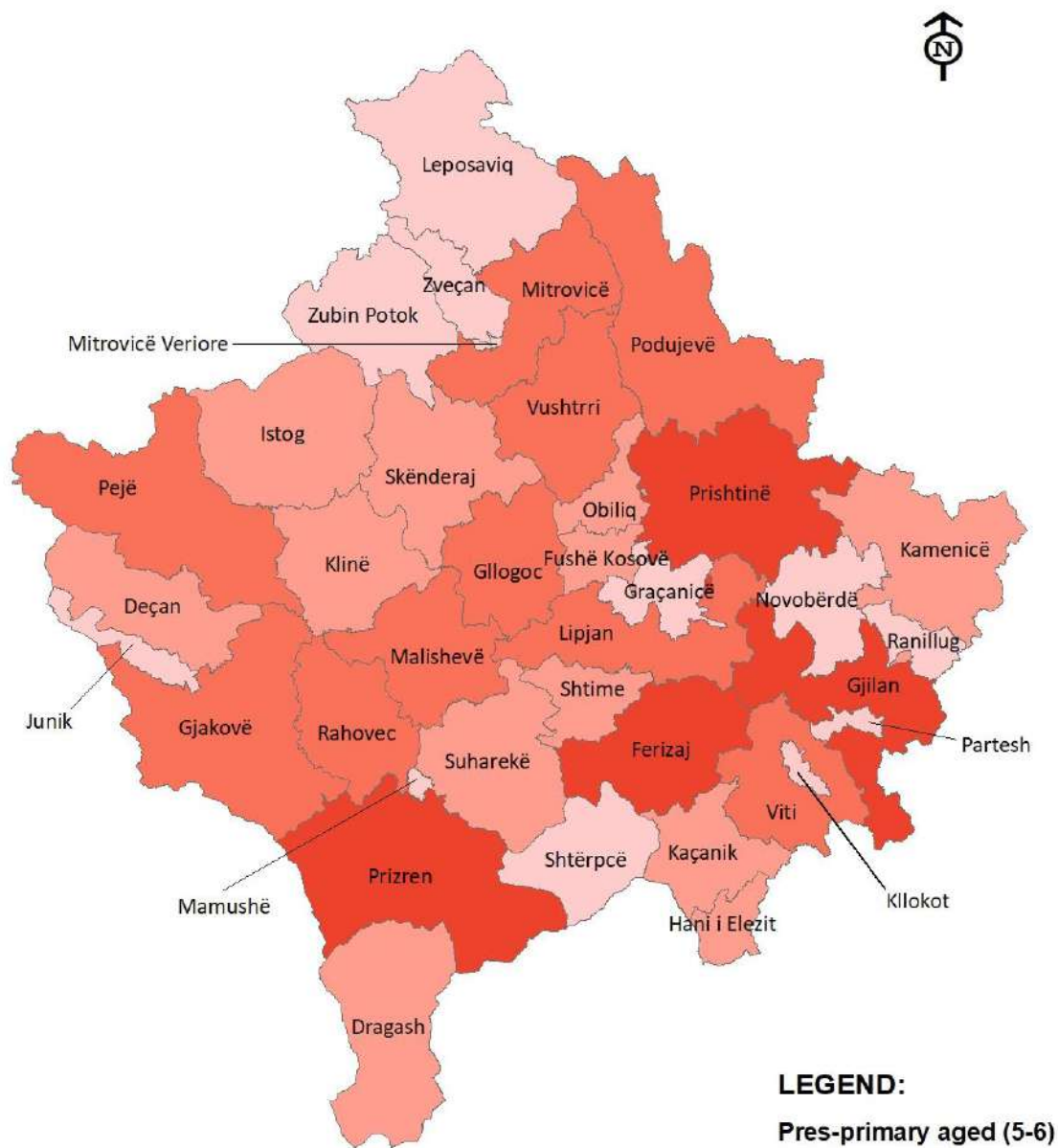

NUMBER OF CHILDREN PRELIMINARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY, 2024/2025

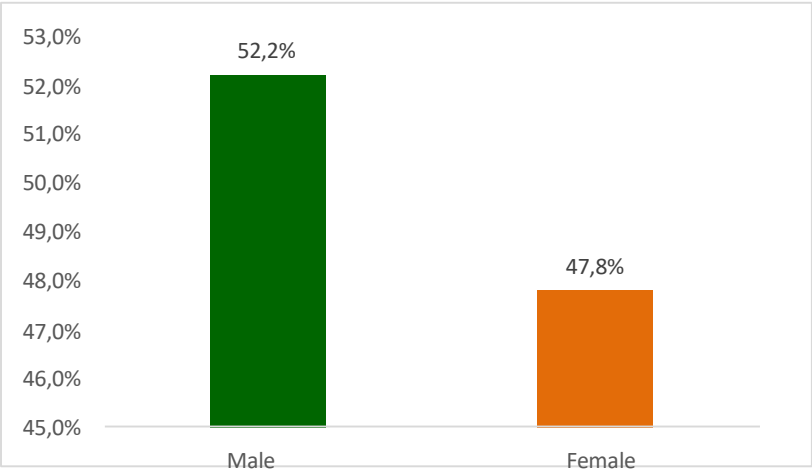

This level of education includes children aged 5 and is organized in kindergartens. and in primary and lower secondary school facilities.

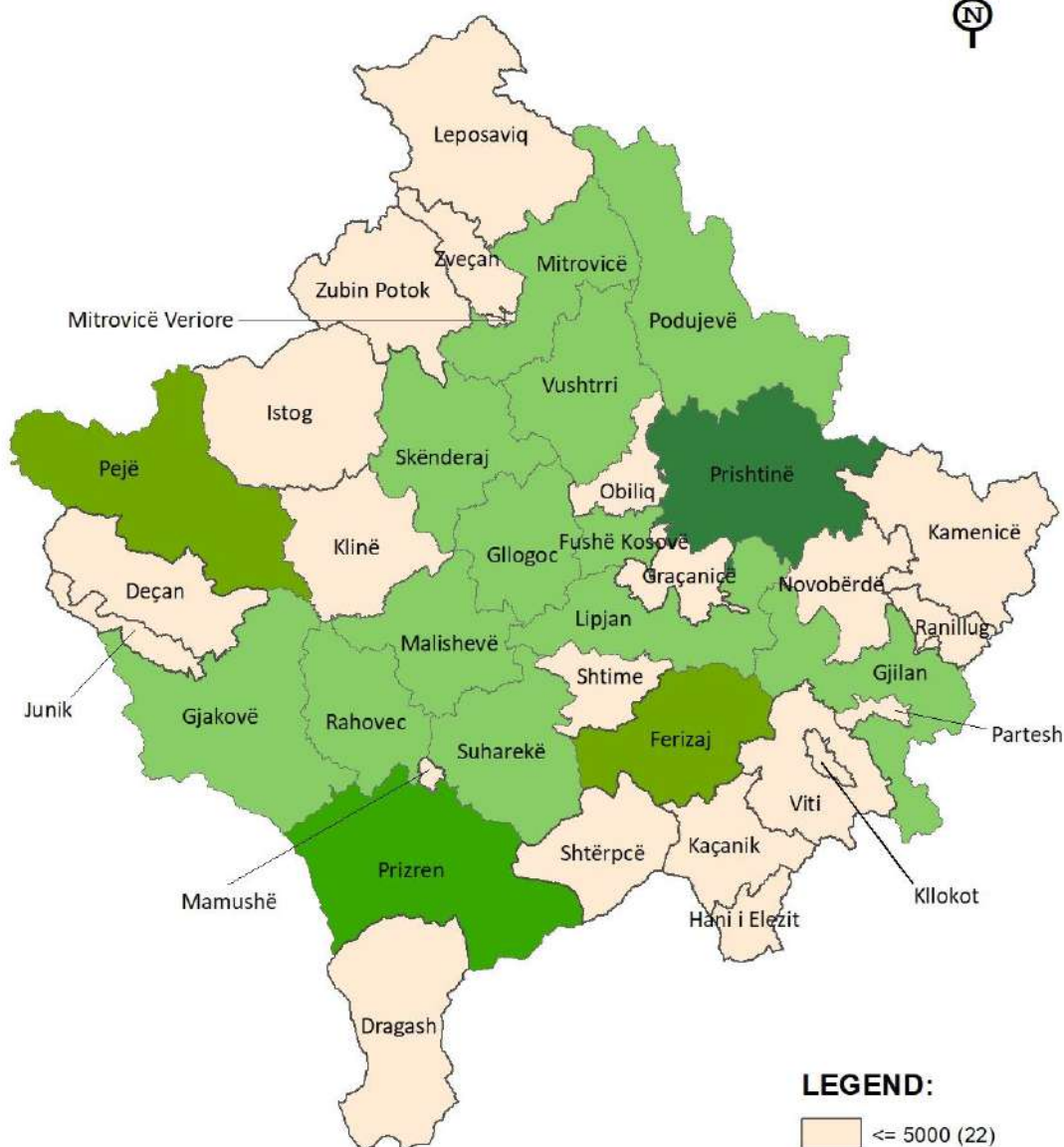

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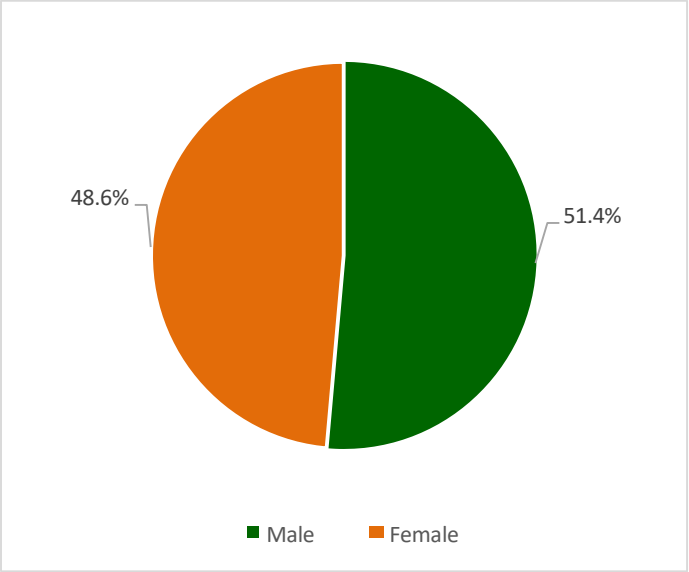

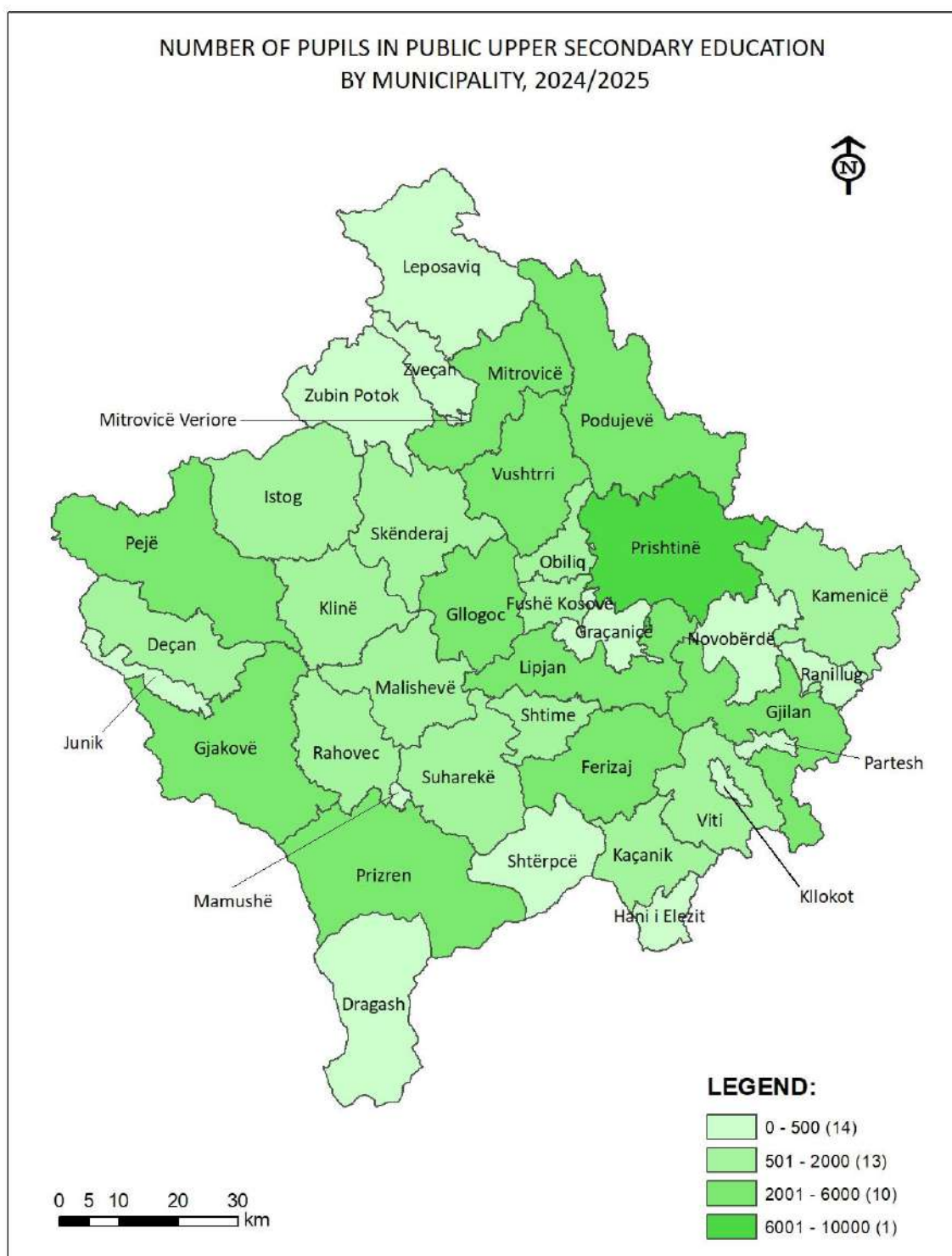

NUMBER OF PUPILS IN PUBLIC UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY, 2024/2025

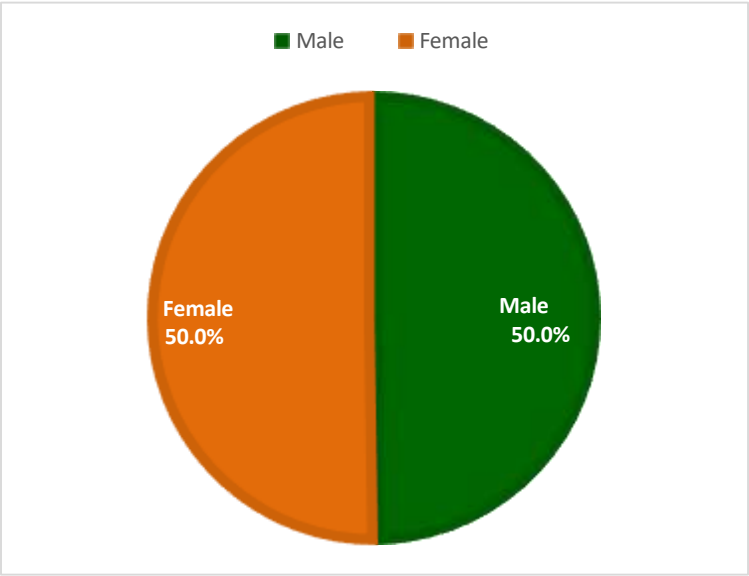

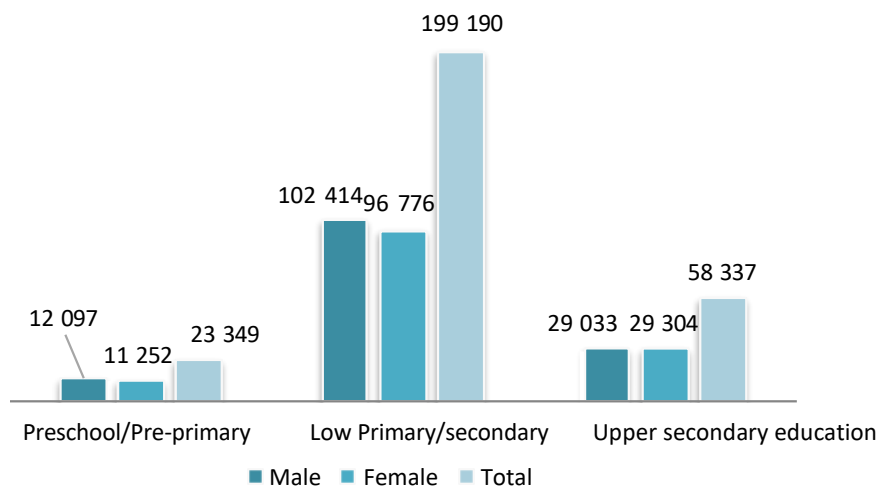
Graph 4. Gender structure in high secondary education

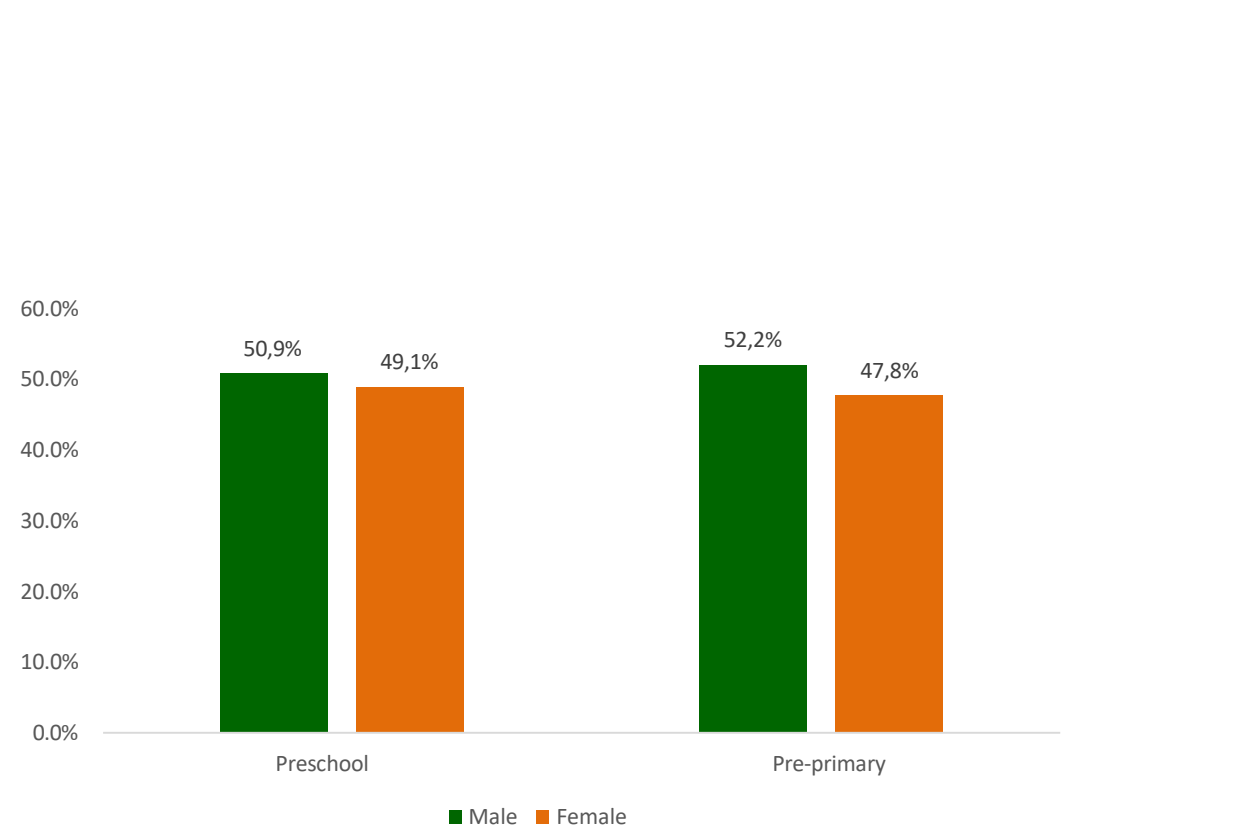
Graph 5. Number The students according to levels

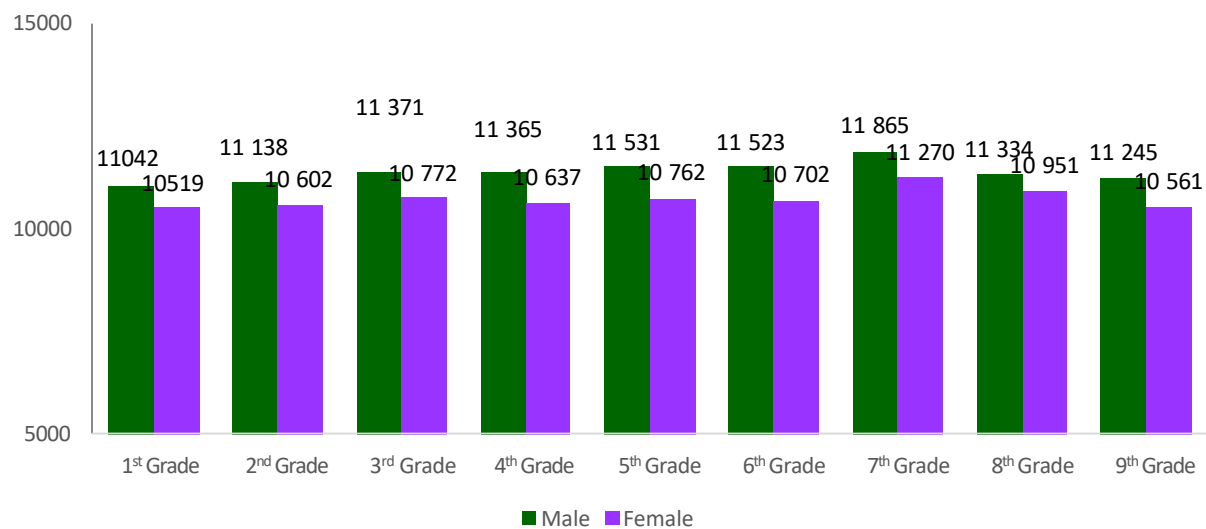


Graph 6. Number of children in preschool/pre-primary level by gender in %

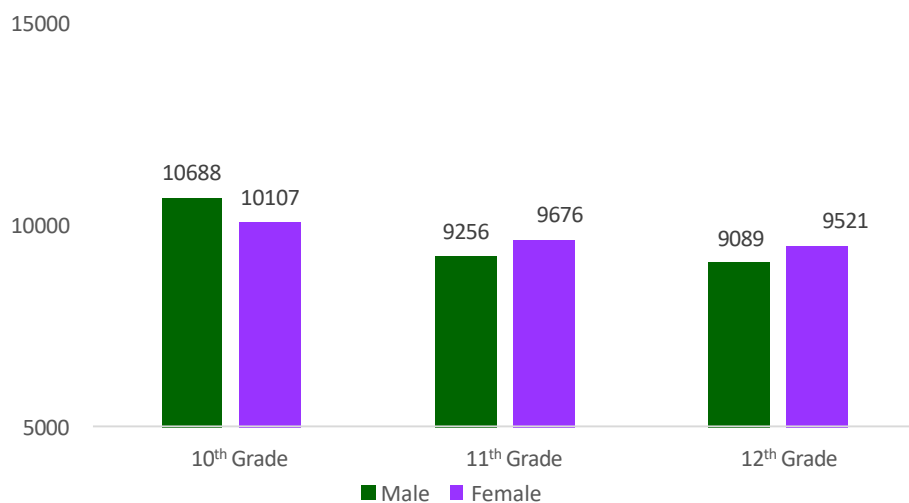


Graph 7. Number of students in primary education and low secondary education according to grades

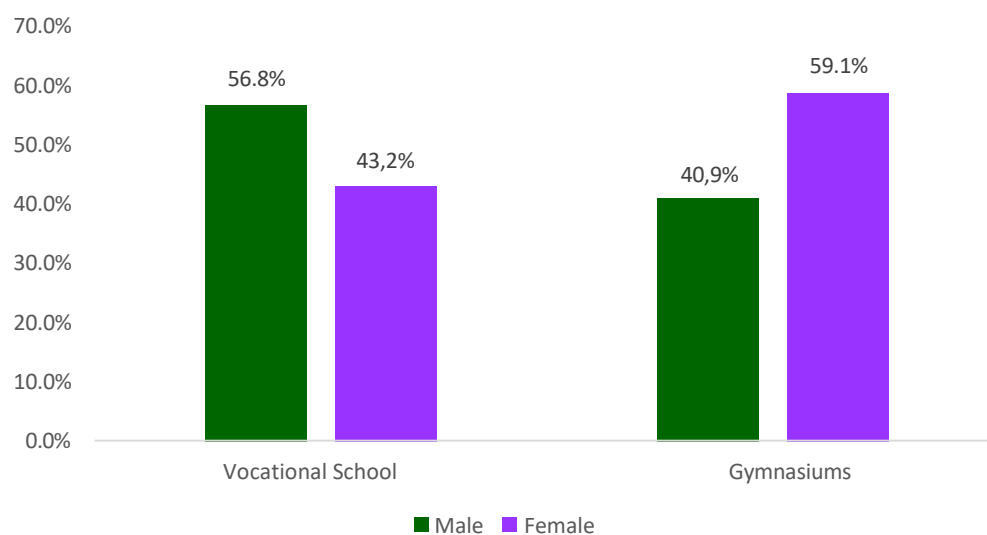


Graph 8. Number of students in upper secondary education by grade

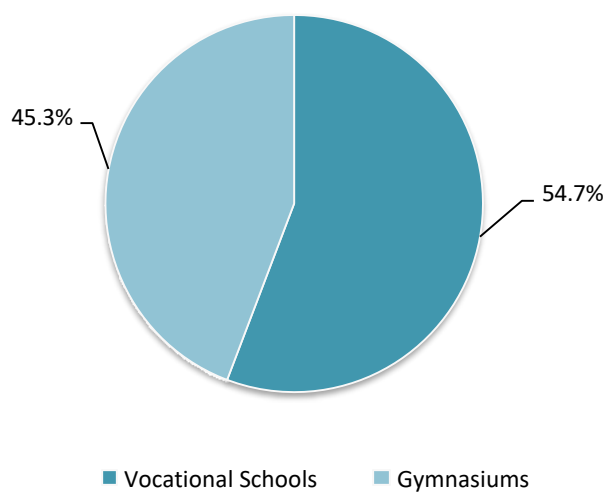

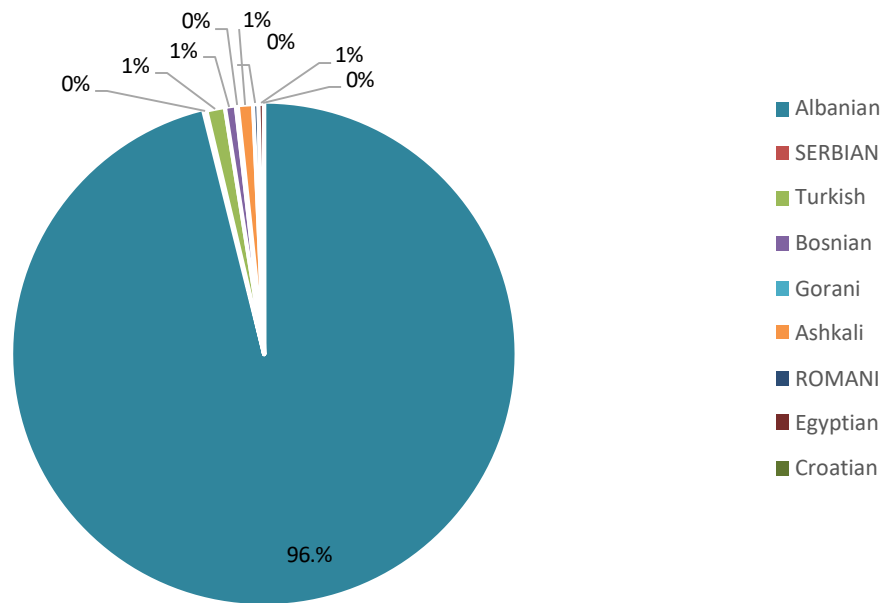

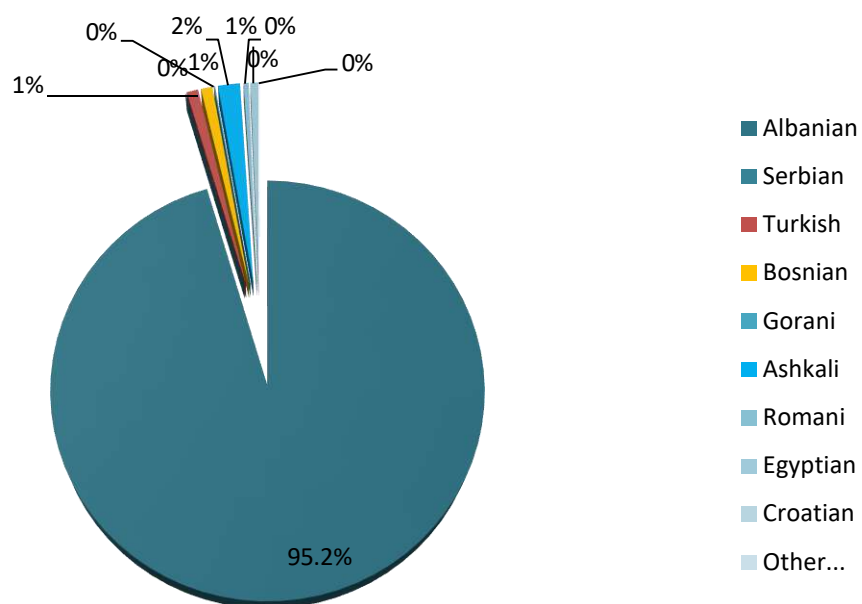
Graph 11. Number of children in pre-primary education according to ethnic background in %

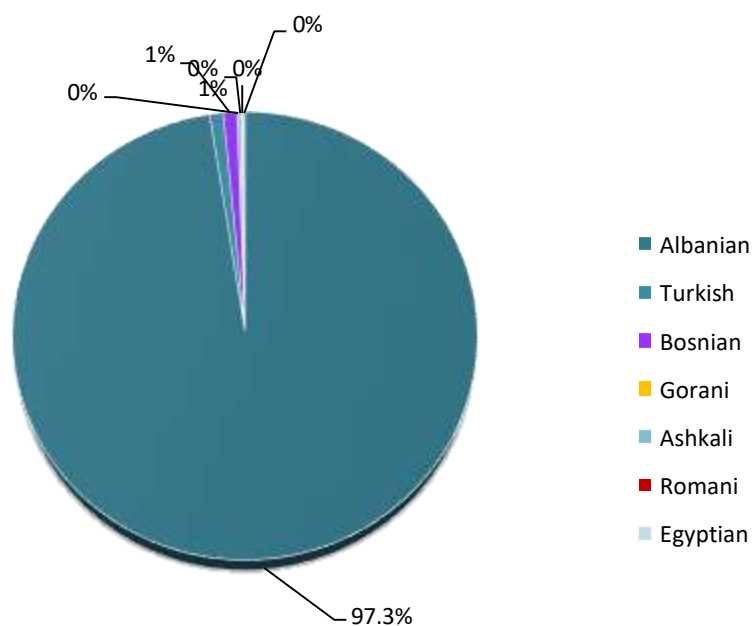
Graph 12. Number of students in primary and lower secondary education by ethnic background in %

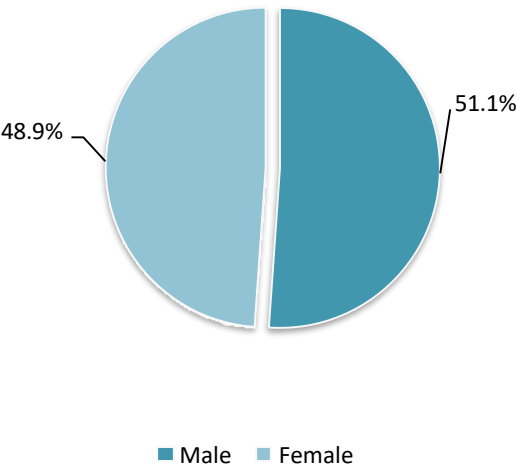


Graph 13. Number of students in high secondary education by ethnic background in %

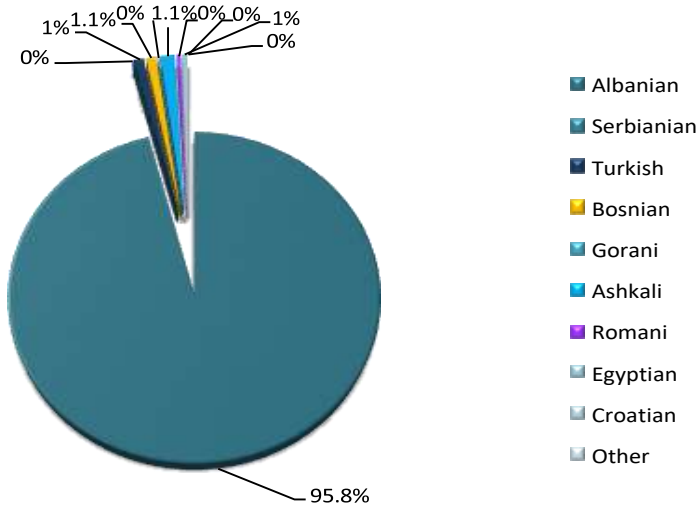
Graph 14. Number of children/students according to group age/grades %

Graph 15. Ethnic structure in pre-university education

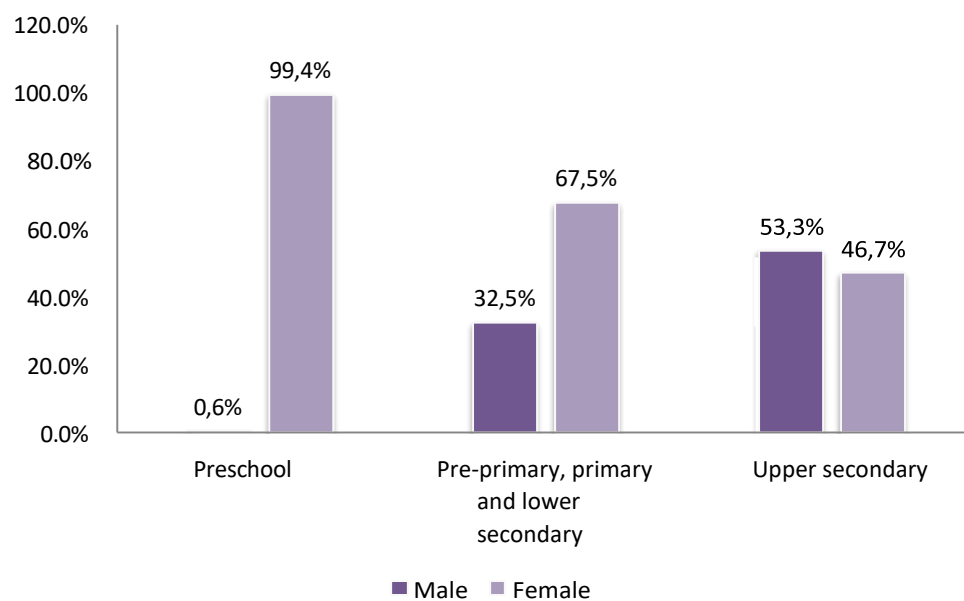

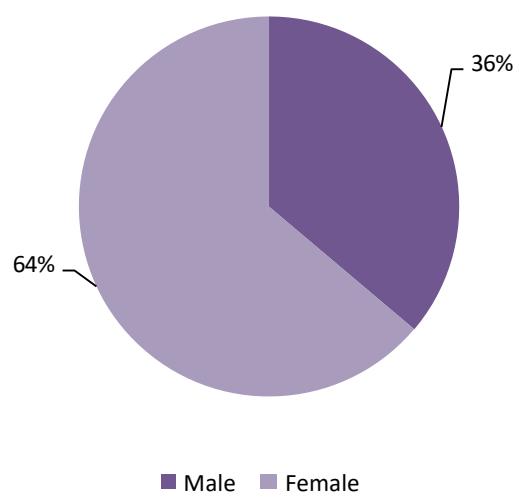


Graph 16. Teachers according to levels in %

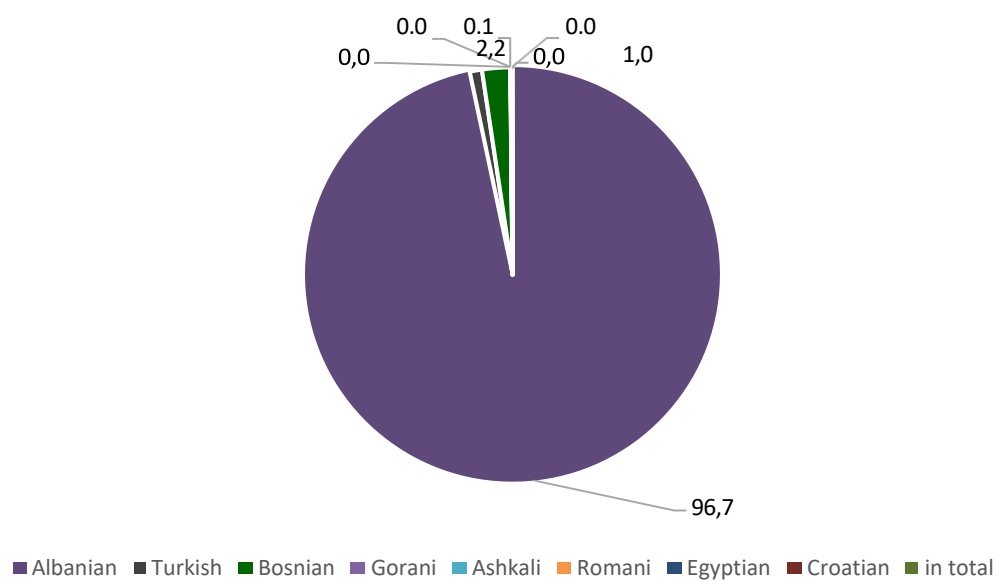
Graph 17. Teachers according to gender in %

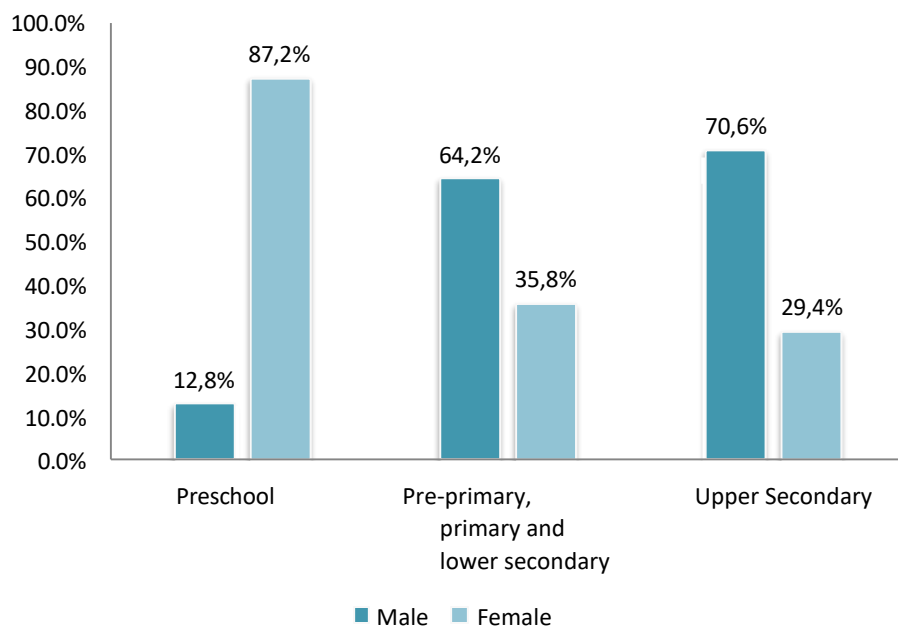


Graph 18. Teachers by ethnic background %

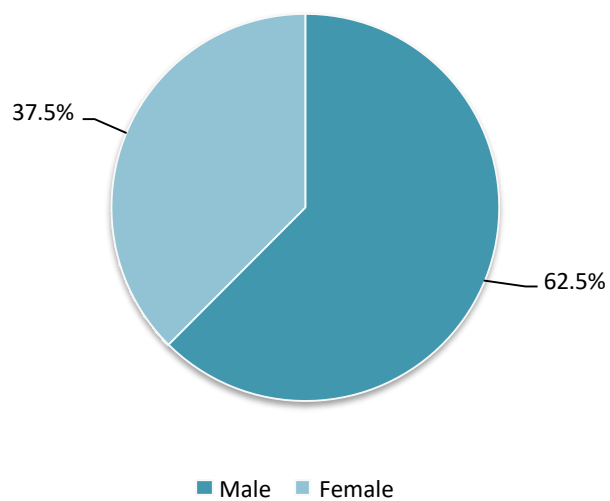


Graph 19. Administrative personnel according to gender for different levels in %

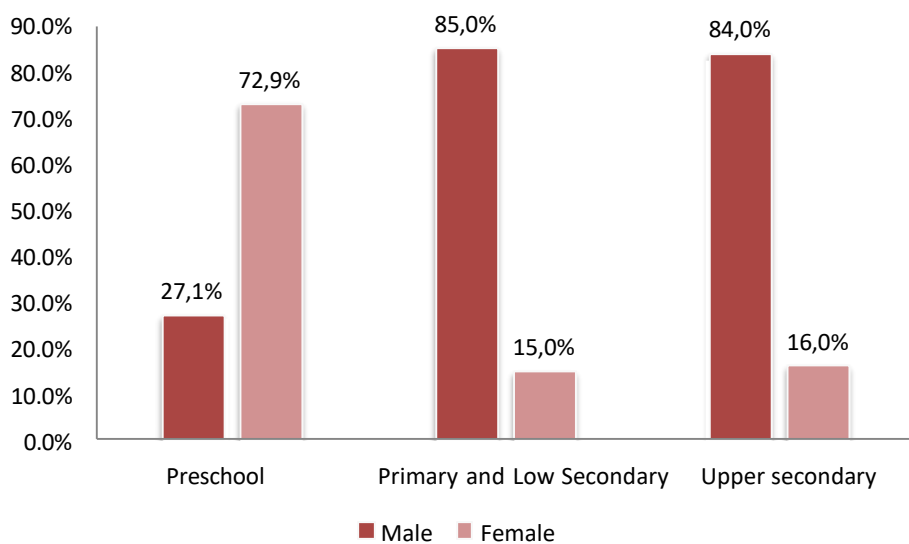


Graph 20. Administrative personnel by gender in %

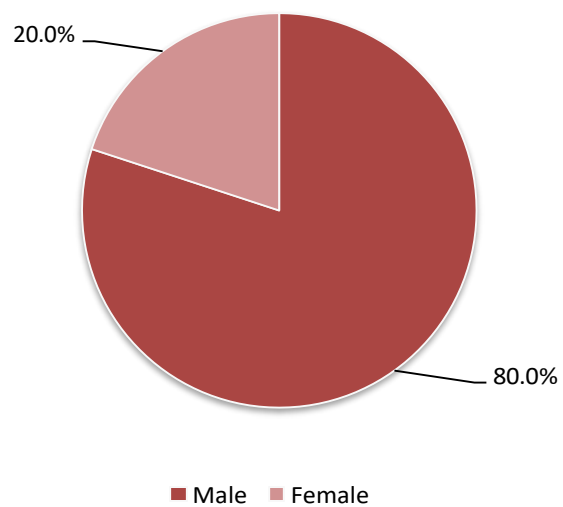


Graph 21. Supporting personnel by levels in %

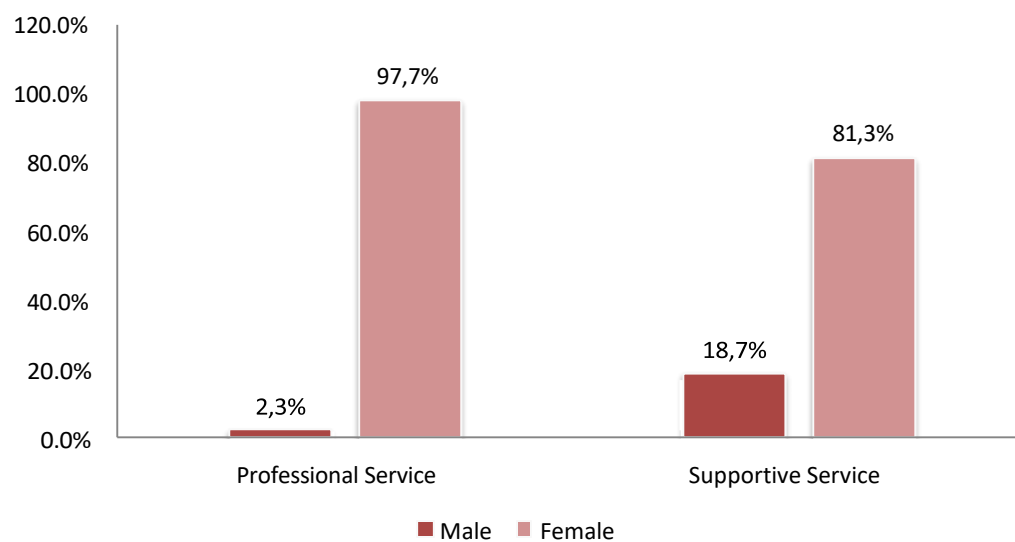


Graph 22. Supporting personnel by gender in %

Graph 23. Professional and Supportive Service by gender in %

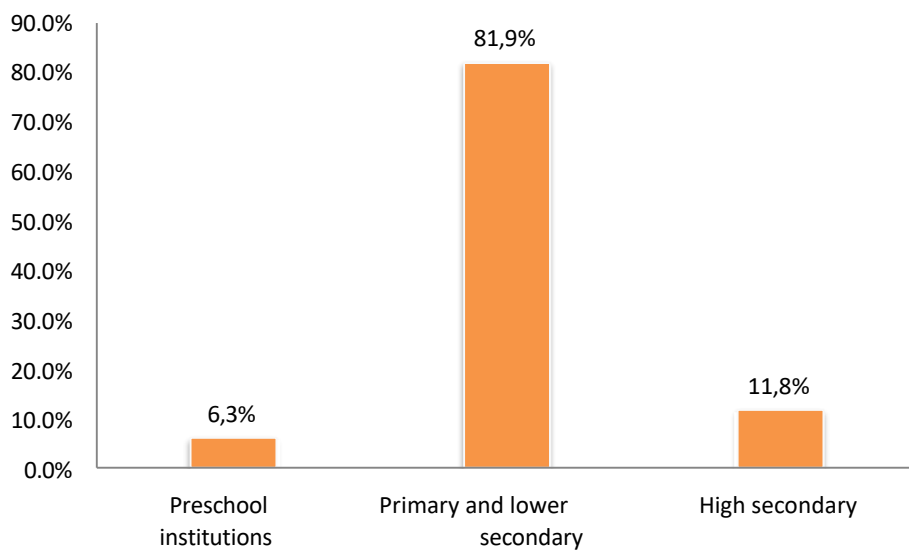

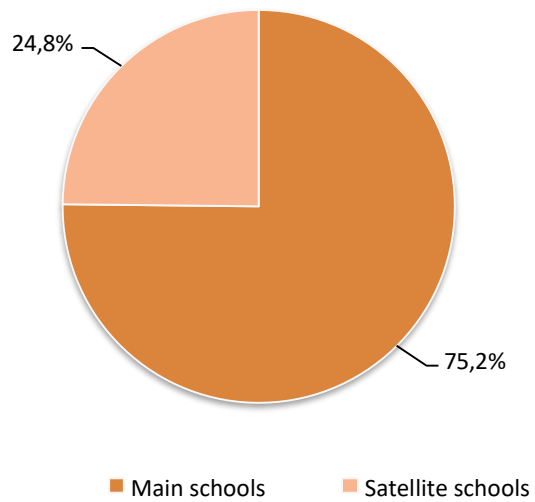
Graph 24. Educational institutions by levels

Graph 25. Educational institutions: primary schools and separate classes in %

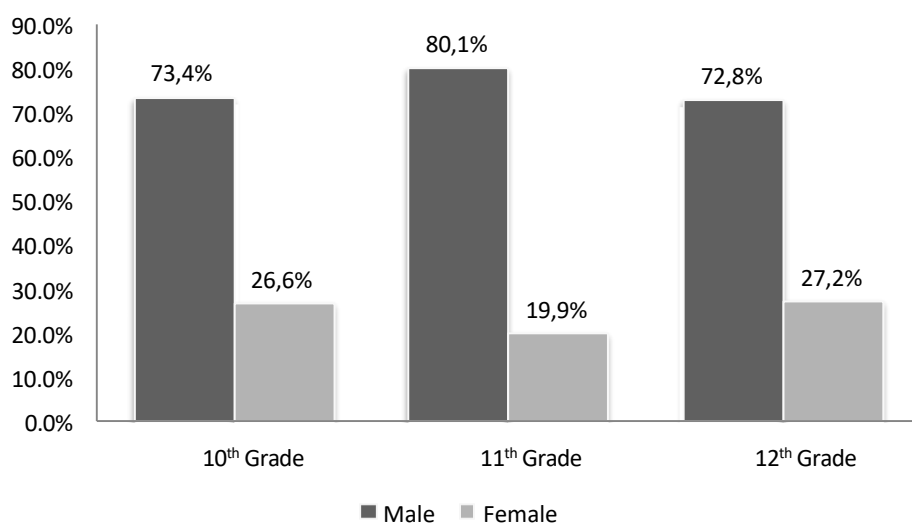

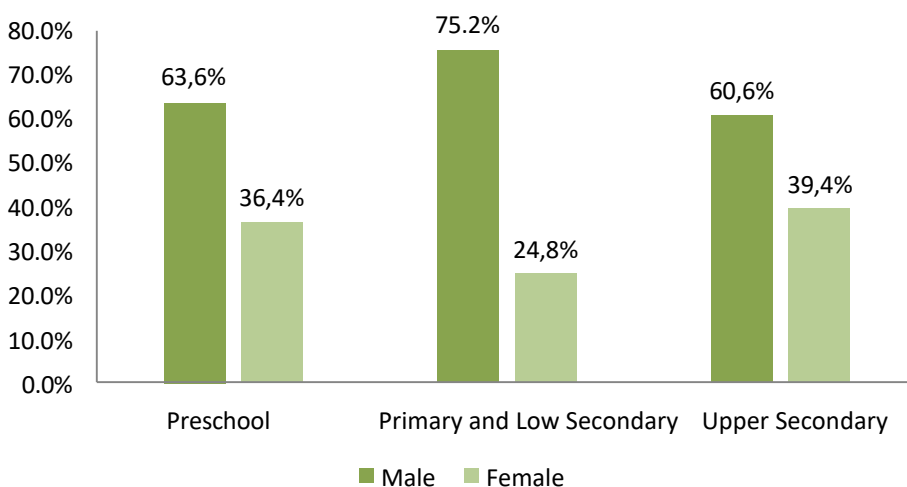

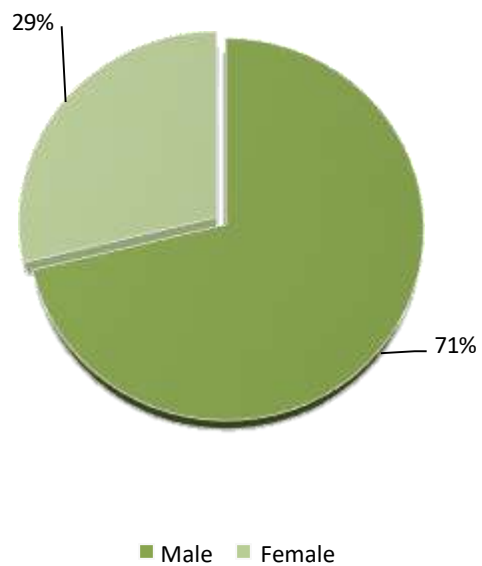

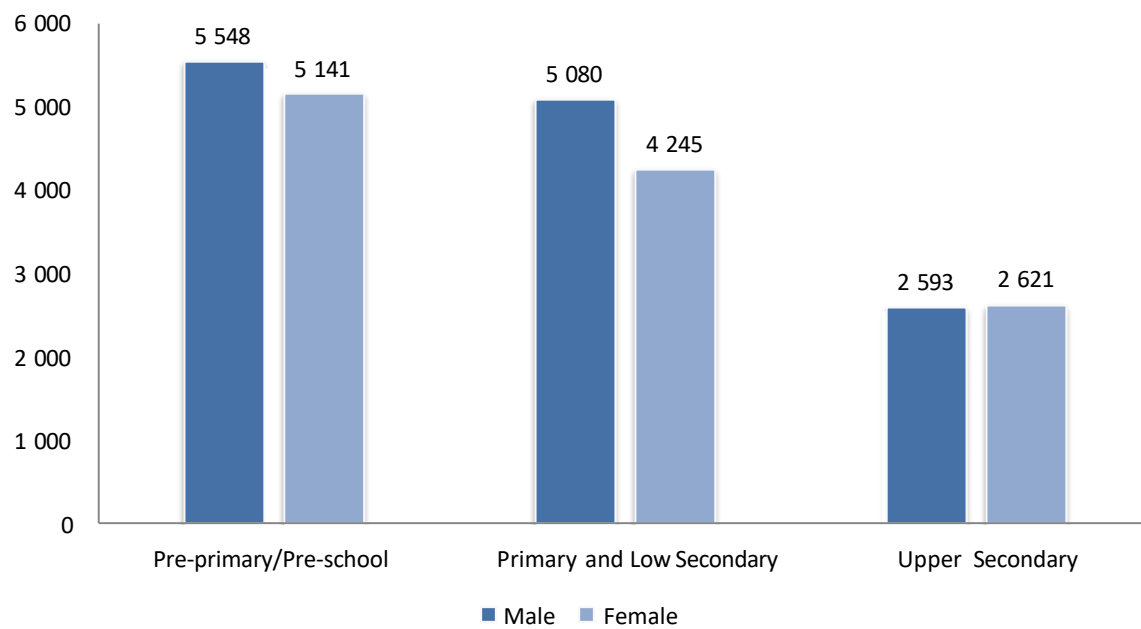

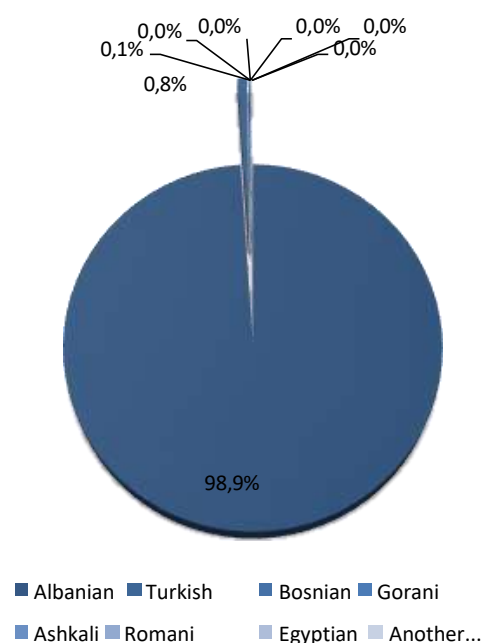


Graph 29. Number of children/students in private education by level

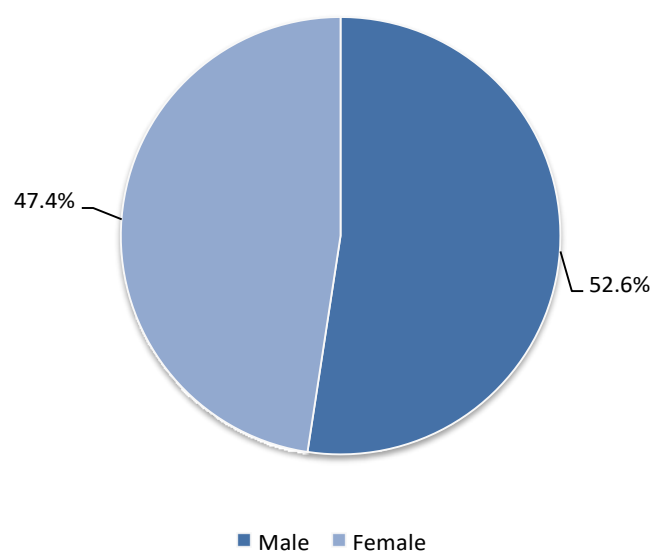


Graph 30. Number of children/students by ethnic background in private pre-university education

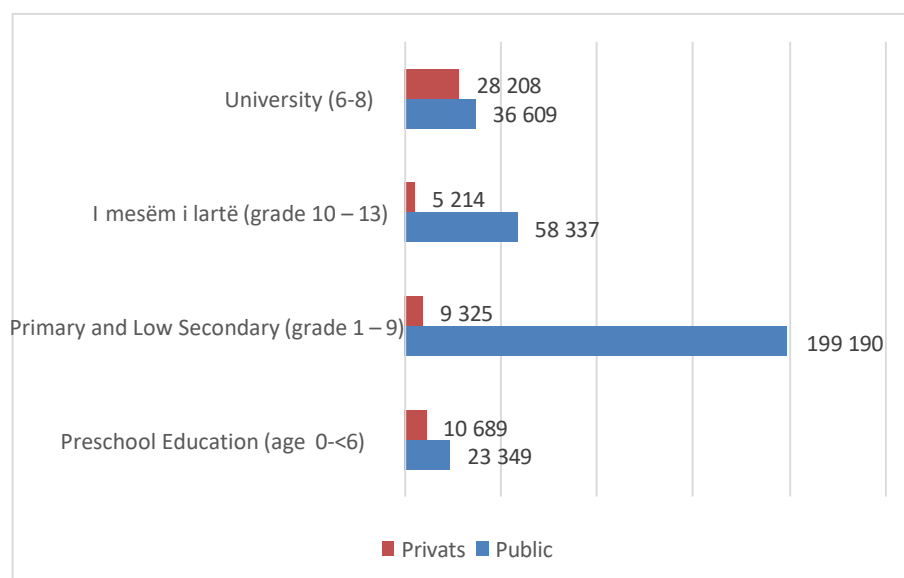

short description

Kosovo Agency of Statistics is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Agency has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Now the Agency operates in the frames of the Office of the Prime Minister's. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics acts according to the Law No. 04/L-036 which entered into force on 12.12.2011 and Amendment of Law No. 06/L-058 which entered into force on 17.01.2019 . Programme of Official Statistics 2018/2022 is in implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT).

Kosovo Agency of Statistics has this organizational structure: production departments; Department of Economic statistics, Department of National Accounts, Department of Agriculture and Environment statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments;** Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Policy Planning, Coordination and Communication, Department of Census and survey and Department of Administration. **Within the Agency are also established Regional Offices;** Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Pristina and Ferizaj

In KAS are employed in total 156 workers, of whom 115 at the headquarters of the Agency, while in the Regional Offices, 41. Agency's educational qualifying structure is as follows: 123 with university education, 15 with non-tertiary education, and 18 with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all Ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNVEF, and with the statistical institutions of the countries in the region.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

In 2011, the project of Population Census , Households and Dwellings was successfully implemented, and in 2014 was successfully carried out the Agriculture Census. The result obtained from these censuses will have an important role in the development policies.

The mission of the Agency; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.
